

Featherweight Maintenance Class

Things you should bring to with you

1. Working featherweight sewing machine. It can be black, white or tan. If you just bought it at a yard sale or it's been sitting in a closet for years, take the time to plug it in and see if it works. If not, contact me before and we'll get you up and operational.
2. A small flat bladed screwdriver. One came with your machine when it was new. If you have two, bring both... your friend sitting next to you may have forgotten. I will have a few spares in case you both forget.
3. A cheap small flashlight for looking into the various nooks and crannies. I get mine from the dollar store. They sell screw drivers too.
4. Scissors
5. A small piece of material for sewing
6. A Bobbin and thread
7. An old bath towel to place your treasure on while working on it

A cleaning kit. There is a fee of \$10 payable to the instructor at the time of the class.

This will provide you with everything you will need for the day.

Should you want to forego the cleaning kit you will need:

Sewing machine oil (available at Walmart, JoAnn's, most quilt shops and sewing centers)

Lube (available from www.novamontgomery.com, sewing centers, etc.)

Paper towels

Q-Tips

Rubber gloves

Tooth brush

The last four items can be bought at the dollar store.

This class will save you money every time you service your machine yourself.

It's easy to do. The materials in your kit will be enough for several services.

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
